Meenon Town Board Meeting Minutes February 17, 2025

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 6:3 p.m. by Chairman Sybers. Supervisor O'Brien was not in attendance.

Notice was posted in accordance with Wis. Stats. 19.84 Open Meeting Law.

On a motion by Strese, seconded by Sybers, the agenda order was approved as presented.

On a motion by Strese, seconded by Sybers, the January 2025 minutes were approved as presented.

Bob Pardun was present to set Open Book and Board of Review dates. Open Book will be held on Monday, May 5, 2025, 6:00-8:00 p.m., Board of Review will be held on Monday, May 12, 2025, 6:00-8:00 p.m. Mr. Pardun also noted that training is now required every year.

Mark Krause from Wagner Surveying presented the Maple Terrace Plat for approval. Motion by Strese to approve the Maple Terrace Plat, 1st edition, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.

The Board was updated on what is happening at the Land Use Planning Committee.

Officer Mangen was present to inform the Board on what they have been doing in the township.

The Treasurer's report was presented for approval. Motion by Strese to approve the report as presented, seconded by Sybers, motion carried.

Supervisors Report - Strese mentioned that he and Chairman Sybers should take the 1 ton out and check the bridges. Intersections should be cleaned up and made wider. We should look at adding gravel to Krause Road this spring.

Chairman's Report - Sybers has been out plowing and sanding. Appliances have been ordered for the new town hall. The smell in the big truck has been figured out. The oil block heater has shorted out and the truck runs too hot. Cooked oil which created the smell. It was cleaned out and is much better now. The fuel line and shocks have been fixed on the small truck. Blades need to be ordered and changed on the big truck. The county will order for the townships.

LRIP - the small LRIP can be used for wedging Fairgrounds Road, cracks, spray patching on Old 35. Big LRIP can be used for old 35 from Airport Road to County Road D.

Strese asked about 35 in front of Wilke's place. Sybers is concerned with what is under the road. Strese thinks it is all clay. They will go through the roads to see which would be the best road for the big LRIP. Peterson still needs to be blacktopped to Mansfield Road, more chipping should be done, spray patching and also Compeau Road by the swamp.
