

Meenon Town Board
Meeting Minutes
October 20, 2025

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Sybers. (O'Brien was not present)

Notice was posted in accordance with Wis. Stats. 19.84 Open Meeting Law.

Motion by Strese to approve the agenda order as presented, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.

Motion by Strese to approve the September minutes, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.

Motion by Strese to approve the Treasurer's report as presented, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Mr. Lange asked about his request to have double yellow lines on Hwy 70. Sybers told him that it was being put back on the November Traffic Safety Committee meeting. Ms. Kratzke asked if a shed could be put on a piece of property on Pike Lake Road or does it have to go to the LUPC for rezoning. Sybers told her that no rezoning is required.

Bob Pardun was present to discuss the contract for Meenon. Bob has hired Sonja Rikkola to help with the assessment duties per the contract with the township. Bob introduced Sonja. We were given a copy of her resume and given the oath of office; she will forward a copy of her license to the Clerk. Sybers made the motion to approve the amended contract as presented by Mr. Pardun, seconded by Strese. Motion carried.

There were no officers from Siren present to discuss the police protective services agreement and no new communication from the Land Use Planning Committee.

The Clerk discussed the budget with the Board and scheduled a working session for Monday, November 10th, 6:00 p.m. The Clerk is working on getting a .gov email address for the Township.

Strese asked about the batteries on the truck. Sybers indicated the batteries had been charged for about 3 weeks and when he tried the truck, it started.

Sybers indicated that the blacktopping on Peterson Road and the area on the hill of Pike Bend Road should have been started. Siren's section of Lakeview has also been started. There is a Town's Association meeting on Thursday. There is a 2-year trial period for LRIP vetting committee for the county, Sybers will be on that committee. At the fire association meeting the budget was discussed, the budget did go up 2%. \$4,000.00 will be put in the account which pays the fire fighters. Currently there are 24 fire fighters. Many tools have been purchased from the money they received through fund raisers. Fire blankets were also purchased. The fire department will start looking for a ladder truck. Winter brushing on Leghorn and Lakeview needs to be completed. Strese asked if we could get quotes for brushing and tree removal.
