

TOWN OF MEENON  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
MONDAY, JANUARY 19, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Sybers (O'Brien was not in attendance).

Notice was posted in accordance with Wis. Stats 19.84 Open Meeting Law

Motion by Strese to approve the agenda order, seconded by Sybers, motion carried.

The minutes of the December 15, 2025, meeting were presented for approval. Motion by Strese to approve the minutes, seconded by Sybers, Motion carried.

December 2025 Treasurer's report was presented for approval. Motion by Strese to approve the Treasurer's report as presented, seconded by Sybers, motion carried.

Public Comments: None

Motion by Strese to approve the Operator's License requested by Haylie Tideman, Midtown Tavern, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.

The Siren police officer was present to discuss the January activities in Meenon. There were 4 drug related stops, 2 calls, burning, 7 police contacts and a discussion on the house on North Bass Lake Road. Also, the Intergovernmental Police Protective Services Agreement by and between the Village of Siren and the Town of Meenon, Amendment #1 - May 28, 2025, was presented to the Board for approval. Motion by Sybers, seconded by Strese. Motion carried.

Discussion on the bill from Tank for the town hall, Oakland has questions on the bill.

ARPA - Motion by Sybers to close out the ARPA account and transfer the interest that is left in the account to the Town Hall account. Seconded by Strese. Motion carried.

Supervisor's report - speed limit information in the WTA magazine.

Chairman's report - the roads have been sanded and widened. 1 ton is leaking again. Brushing has not started. Upcoming meetings: January 21st - Fire Association, January 22nd - WTA meeting. Sybers and Strese went through the BCHD bills. Sybers explained the LRIP, TRIP-D and TRIP-S grants. Some have been applied for. There is also a Safe Route to School grant available, which would work for Fairgrounds Road. Discussions on possible road work for 2026, some of those projects are: Chip from D north to FF; Chelmo - ½ mile; ½ mile on Lakeview; Pike Bend is prepped almost 2 miles; Old 35, 2 miles. The Fire Department is looking at purchasing a Ladder Truck - they might have to get a small loan, about 30,000 - 40,000.

The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, February 16, 2026.

Motion by Strese to pay the bills, seconded by Sybers, motion carried.
