

TOWN OF MEENON
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 15, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Chairman C. Sybers at 6:30 p.m. (Strese absent)

Notice was posted in accordance with Wis. Stats. 19.84 Open Meeting Law.

Approval of agenda order - motion by Sybers, seconded by O'Brien. Motion carried.

Approval of April 2026 minutes - motion by O'Brien, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.

April 2026 Treasurer's Report was presented for approval. Motion by O'Brien, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Mr. Lange mentioned that there were potholes on Midtown Road. Ms. Kratzer asked about a fire number for the property at 7041 County Road A, Sybers told her that the homeowner would have to order it from the Land Use Office, but the township will install it when it arrives. Ms. Kratzer also mentioned that there is a pothole on Pike Lake that needs attention.

2026-2027 Liquor Licenses were presented for approval. Motion by Sybers to approve all as presented, seconded by O'Brien. Motion carried. 2026-2027 Operator's Licenses were presented for approval. Motion by Sybers to approve the operator's licenses as presented, seconded by O'Brien. Motion carried.

Supervisor's report: O'Brien met with Sand Lake regarding joint roads. An email should be coming from the Sand Lake Clerk. Meenon will take care of the stop sign until we agree on a contract.

Chairman report: Sybers spoke with the county on roads. Spray patching will be completed by the county from the top of the hill on Old 35 to Fairgrounds Road. Sybers ordered the 45 mph signs for the Bass Lake area. There are fire numbers that will be put up. Signs will be ordered for Fairgrounds Road, Wood Chuck Lane (private Road) and Compeau Road (South side). The Fire Department has their new ladder truck, they indicated that it works well. Road discussion, Chelmo is in good condition to chip, double chipping will be done on Lakeview, Midtown by Davis Drive (kind of low, it should be raised a bit). A van is parked on Leghorn that is just about on the road, an email has been sent to the Siren Police Department. Pike Bend up to Kruger Road on Midtown from the cemetery to board landing and gravel on shoulders. Corcoran is not ideal to work on right now. Davis Drive could be chipped (if we have extra funds) and Davidson. Old 35 - spray patched to Moline. Pike Lake road. Driveway permits have been signed and returned.

Next meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 20, 2026 (O'Brien will not be present).

Motion by O'Brien to pay the bills, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.
