

TOWN OF MEENON
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 17, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Chairman C. Sybers at 6:30 p.m.

Notice was posted in accordance with Wis. Stats. 19.84 Open Meeting Law.

Approval of agenda order - motion by Strese, seconded by O'Brien. Motion carried.

Approval of July 2026 minutes - motion by Strese, seconded by O'Brien. Motion carried.

July 2026 Treasurer's Report was presented for approval. Motion by Strese, seconded by O'Brien. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Has anything been accomplished with Sheldon's semi parked on the road side? The certified letter which was sent to him was returned with no signatures. It was suggested that the semi be towed by the township and put in storage. The Clerk was instructed to check with Chief Thies on the legality of and process of this. We also should check on if a notice in the paper is required. Bill Johnson said he attended the County Safety meeting and was wondering about speed limits.

Strese asked if Chris Maslowski was still working for us because the old town hall property needs to be cleaned up. What are we going to do with the old town hall building? Also, will we be winterizing the garage soon? We will be adding insulation and redoing some of the area. Will we have enough propane through Northwoods seeing as we will be using more this winter for the garage. Gravel is needed in the driveway after removing stumps. Is the water tank that we put brine in on the little truck going to be replaced? Chipping has started. Sybers gave the county a list of roads to be worked on by them. Some of these roads are Lakeview, Old 35 from D to FF, Chelmo, Moline, Pike Bend from Mansfield to Kruger. O'Brien suggested that we do something with Connors Bridge Road and Old A 1 & 2. Sybers indicated that there are some thumpers on Connors Bridge Road that he would like to see get fixed first. What about John Stone. Davis Drive - too low to chip this year, we will need a 2" lift, have it graded and let it sit for the winter. Chip next year. Rest of Midtown from top of hill to the boat landing. Street signs need to be ordered, speed limit signs for the Bass Lake area have been received but not put up yet. Mowing went well, however, the tractor was over heating.

Wade Wambolt, Fire Chief of the Webster Fire Department was given the official oath of office.

The Chairman, Clerk and Treasurer signed the Shady Oaks 2nd addition plat which Mark Krause provided.

Ordinance No. 2026-01 was presented for approval. The Clerk explained what the ordinance is, which is that the offices of the Town Clerk and the office of the Town Treasurer shall be filled by appointment of a majority of the members-elect of the Town Board. Motion by O'Brien to approve the ordinance, seconded by Strese. Motion carried. There were no questions by audience members and all present (5) also were in favor of the ordinance.

The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, September 21, 2026.

Adjourned to closed session at 7:29 p.m. on a motion by Strese, seconded by O'Brien to confer with legal counsel (via phone) for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to pending litigation involving Grisen and Mueller 2022 auto accident.

Reconvened at 7:37 p.m. on a motion by O'Brien, seconded by Strese. Motion carried. Motion to accept the action from legal counsel by O'Brien, seconded by Strese. Motion carried.

Motion by Strese to pay bills, seconded by O'Brien. Motion carried.
