

TOWN OF MEENON
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
JULY 20, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Chairman C. Sybers at 6:30 p.m. (O'Brien Absent, Strese by phone)

Notice was posted in accordance with Wis. Stats. 19.84 Open Meeting Law.

Approval of agenda order - motion by Sybers, seconded by Strese. Motion carried.

Approval of April 2026 minutes - motion by Sybers, seconded by Strese. Motion carried.

April 2026 Treasurer's Report was presented for approval. Motion by Sybers, seconded by Strese. Motion carried.

Public Comments: Data Centers - County has a sub-committee working on the zoning for them. What are the helicopters that have been around the area? Mr. Lang - there is a dock and boat on Midtown public landing.

Midtown Road (T. Catlin) - Ms. Catlin thanked the Board for the 45 mph sign on Midtown Road, The garbage still remains a problem, she thinks that some of it is coming from the bar (cans, etc.), Ms. Catlin has neighbors that are willing to help pick up trash. Could she get a general idea of when the grass will be cut so she can make arrangements to have the garbage picked up? Could the township ask the tavern to help pick up the garbage seeing as some of it is from their patrons? Sybers will pick up the trash bags on the side of the road. The last time Ms. Catlin called Sybers about the grass being mowed, Sybers said he had it mowed within 2 weeks. Ms. Catlin believes there should be better communication from the township for home owners on this. How do we fix the problem? This must be addressed, can they get help from the bar once a year with this?

Wagner Surveying - Shady Oaks 2nd addition plat - Mark Krause presented the 2nd addition plat for approval. Motion to approve by Strese, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried. Signatures for the plat will be done at a later date.

No police report. However, Sybers asked for the Ordinances related to the Siren Police Department be sent to Adam Benson. He is working on an OWI case from Midtown Road.

Chairman's report: There was an accident on Connor's and Austin Lake Road - nothing was obstructing the stop sign. Sybers has been out mowing, getting many compliments on the job he has done. There is a problem with the blacktop breaking off on Austin Lake road, Sybers will check with the County. County started something new with using liquid weed killer on the sides of the road. The Clerk was instructed to send a thank you note to Polk Burnett again for allowing M. Strese to help with mowing.

The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, August 17, 2026.

Motion by Strese to pay the bills, seconded by Sybers. Motion carried.
